REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 16 years of age or older
- Eligibility to obtain work permit from your High School if still enrolled.
- Upon hire must possess:
 - Lifeguard training, First Aid/CPR/AED provided by the American Red Cross, or Equivalent.
- Knowledge of:
 - Techniques and methods of swimming instruction for all age levels;
 - Principles and practices of preventive lifeguarding, water rescues, first aid and CPR;
 - Proper English usage, vocabulary, spelling punctuation, and grammar
 - Pool Cleaning and maintenance
- Physical Requirements:
 - Ability to work out doors in all types of weather and be able to withstand frequent exposure to hot, wet, and humid conditions.
 - Ability to work at different locations throughout the district
 - Ability to quickly enter and exit pool and assist patrons with the same
 - Swimming with proficiency and endurance
 - Ability to communicate with patrons

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supervise patrons and participants in pool and deck area.
- Promote and enforce safety procedures
- Render care in the most current American Red Cross techniques
- Follows written and oral instructions
- Prepares and completes written reports of accidents and incidents
- Applying safe work practices
- Attend all trainings and in-services when provided

- Assists in general upkeep of pool and office area and surrounding facility
- Other duties as assigned

All candidates must file an application at the Bear Mountain Recreation and Park District office, 10300 San Diego St. Lamont, CA 93241, (661) 845-0757 on or before **May 1, 2020 by 4:00 p.m.** This position will require a lifeguard certificate. Qualified applicants will be informed of the written and physical examinations time and place.

Applicants must interview in order to move on to the round of written and physical certification tests. The Bear Mountain Recreation will pay for your exam fees. If for any reason you do not pass the exam or remain employed with the department for one full season, you will be required to repay the department the full cost of your exam fee.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Fingerprint clearance by the California Department of Justice is a condition of appointment after all other required job conditions have been met. Some positions may require proof of privately owned automobile insurance and the possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle operator's license.
